### New Friends of MVH:

Those of you that attended the village hall annual meeting in April will be aware of the intention to form a new charity, The Friends of Moggerhanger Village Hall (FoMVH) There are many reasons for the formation of the new charity:

Improved focus to both fund raising and building management, care and maintenance. With the same few folk having to focus on all of these time-consuming activities it is not possible to get everything done. Two separate charities means two separate groups of people thereby reducing the load. FoMVH will focus on the majority of the fund raising activities and will continue to manage the bar, leaving the village hall trustees to focus on the day to day running of the hall, management, care and maintenance of the building. The village hall trustees will still retain responsibility for the 100 club.

Another significant advantage is the ability for FoMVH to act as third party funders in the event of the village hall trustees applying for grants. As a completely separate charity it is possible to make donations or contributions that the village hall trustees are not allowed to make themselves. However, it is not the intention that FoMVH would contribute to the general running costs such as water, electricity or cleaning.

The new charity is now formally in existence although not yet registered with the charity commission. The commission requires accounts to show an ability to raise in excess of

£6000 per annum before a charity can be registered. This we will undertake before the end of this financial year.

FoMVH has four trustees, Joanne Curno, Julia Hobson Cooper, Christine Lloyd and Carolyn Lister.
